Professor F.M.J. Debruyne has been Professor and Chairman of the Department of Urology at the University Medical Center Nijmegen, The Netherlands since 1981. He received his medical degree in 1967 from the University of Louvain in Belgium and completed residencies in surgery and urology at St Johns Hospital in Bruges, Belgium. He finalized his urological training at the University Medical Center in Nijmegen, The Netherlands and did several clinical fellowships in Germany, the UK and Austria. Professor Debruyne was a member of the board of the Dutch Urological Association, chairman of the European Organization for Research and Treatment of Cancer Genito-Urinary (EORTC GU) Group, chairman of the European Society of Urological Research (ESUR) and vice president of the Société Internationale d'Urologie (SIU). He also was a member of the scientific - and later of the management - committee of the European Association of Urology (EAU). In 1992 he became the EAU secretary general, a function he fulfilled for more than 12 years. Professor Debruyne has authored or co-authored more than a thousand articles in peer-reviewed journals
